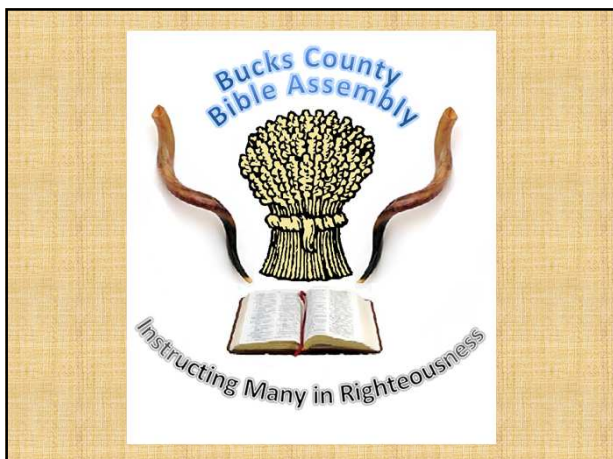

V23 - And Y'HoWShUA himself began to be about **thirty years of age**, being (as was supposed) the son of Joseph, which was the son of Heli,

Now Jesus Himself began *His ministry* at about thirty years of age (NKJV)



Counting Backwards

- 30 AD Passover Wednesday – Y'HoWShUA died
- John's Gospel mentions 3 Passovers = 2 Years => 28 AD
- Y'HoWShUA's birthday – Feast Of Tabernacles
 - Ministry Started Fall 27 AD

V1 - Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,



New Testament Chronology (Kenneth F. Doig)

- Pontius Pilate started as Governor of Judea
Sep 27 AD
- Tiberius Caesar - Emperor 19 Aug 14 (Julian Calendar)
(Luke used the Syro-Macedonian Calendar - starts in October, Reigns are counted inclusive of Year 1)

19 Aug 14 (Julian) is in Oct 13AD – Sep 14 AD (SM)
Counting 15 years from Oct 13 AD = Sep 27 AD

Daniel 9:20-27

V25 - Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.



From King Artaxerxes ...

- Reigned 464BC – 424BC
- 7th Year of reign =
 - March 458BC – March 457BC (Persian)
 - September 458BC – September 457BC (Jewish civil)
- 7 + 62 weeks = 69 weeks = 483 days
- 457BC + 483 + 1 (no year 0) = 27AD



Y'HoWShUA's Birthday

- 30 years old in Sep 27 AD
- 27 AD – 30 = 4 BC (no year 0)
- Born on 15 Tishri 3758 = 4 Oct 4 BC
- Died 14 Nissan 3790 = 3 Apr 30 AD
