







Historical Accuracy

- 10 non Christian writers mention Y'HoShUA in the first 150 years, only 9 mention Tiberius Cesear
- NT written within 40 years of Y'HoShUA's death, Alexander the Great closest at 500 years
 - ~15,000 manuscripts or fragments of the NT, nearest secular work – Homer with 643
 - Earliest NT copies within 50 years of original, the Iliad is next at 500 years















Luke 10:1-12


an injunction, charge, precept, commandment. Vines - It is the most frequent term, and is used of moral and religious precept







For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little:
