V27 - That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but **that it should be holy and without blemish.**

V3 - And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

V6 - Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him.

V24 - And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

V8 - If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

V7-8 - Saying, **Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man to whom YHWH will not impute sin.**

G3049 - λογίζομαι – logizomai
to take into account, to make an account of



Zechariah 14:1-21



Zechariah 14:1-21

V21 - Yea, every pot in Jerusalem and in Judah shall be holiness unto **YHWH** of hosts: and all they that sacrifice shall come and take of them, and see the therein: and in that day there shall be no more the Canaanite in the house of **YHWH** of hosts.



What is holy?

G40 – hagios – ἅγιος - most holy thing, a saint

G37 – hagiozo - ἀγιάζω - To purify; to render or acknowledge, or to be venerable or hallow;
to separate from profane things and dedicate to the Mighty One

H6944 – qodesh – קֹדֶשׁ
holiness, sacredness, **apartness, separateness**

V7 - Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy:
for I am **YHWH** your Mighty One.

V6 - And the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, I will even set my face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people.

Holy – sanskrit - holi = Hindu god
Holi moli – Hindu spring fertility festival
qodesh – קדש - Kadosh






Psalm 4:1-8






Psalm 4:1-8

V3 - But know that **YHWH** hath set apart him that is godly for himself: **YHWH** will hear when I call unto him.



John 17:6-26

John 17:6-26

V16-17 - **They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.**

Sanctify - hagiazo – set them apart

Haggai 2:10-14




Haggai 2:10-14

V13 - Then said Haggai, **If one that is unclean by a dead body touch any of these, shall it be unclean?**
And the priests answered and said, It shall be unclean.



Numbers 19:11-22





Numbers 19:11-22

V11 - **He that toucheth the dead body of any man shall be unclean seven days.**

V19 - And the clean person shall sprinkle upon the unclean on the third day, and on the seventh day: **and on the seventh day he shall purify himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be clean at even.**





Leviticus 23:33-44





Leviticus 23:33-44

V41-42 - And ye shall keep it a feast unto **YHWH** seven days in the year. It shall be a statute for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month. Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born shall dwell in booths:



Isaiah 58:1-14



Isaiah 58:1-14

V13-14 - If thou turn away thy foot from the Sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my set apart day; and **call the Sabbath a delight, the set apart of YHWH, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: Then shalt thou delight thyself in YHWH;** and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of **YHWH** hath spoken it.



James 1:21-27




James 1:21-27

V21 - Therefore **lay aside all filthiness** and overflow of wickedness, and **receive with meekness the implanted word**, which is able to save your souls. (NKJV)

V27 - **Pure and undefiled religion before the Mighty One and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, to keep oneself unspotted from the world.** (NKJV)





1 Corinthians 6:12-20

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

V18-20 - **Flee sexual immorality.** Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body. Or do you not know that **your body is the temple of the Set Apart Spirit in you, whom you have from yhe Mighty One, and you are not your own?** For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify the Mighty One in your body and in your spirit, which are the Mighty One's.
