




Deuteronomy 10:1-5




Exodus 25:10-22



A title; an inscription, giving the accusation of the crime for which a criminal suffered


Vines: See Superscription - denotes "an inscription, a title." On Roman coins the emperor's name was inscribed. In the Roman Empire, in the case of a criminal on his way to execution, a board on which was inscribed the cause of his condemnation, was carried before him or hung round his neck; the inscription was termed a "title" (titlos). The four Evangelists state that at the crucifixion of Messiah the title was


affixed to the cross




V8 – Y'HoShUA the Messiah the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.




Matthew 19:16-22
