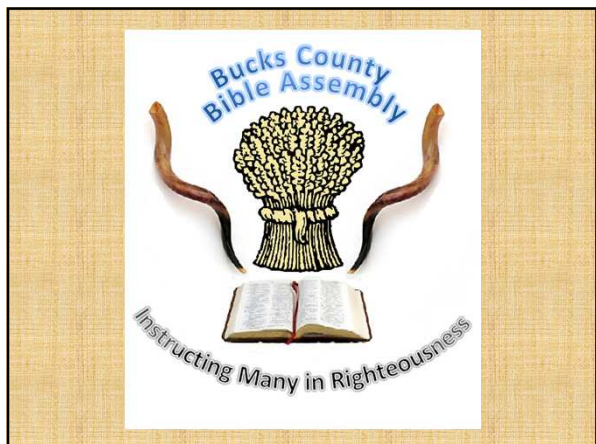

v2 Very early on the first day of the week
- 4) Lk 23:50-24:7** v1 bringing spices they had prepared
v56 Prepared spices and rested on the Sabbath day

V1 - **In the end of the Sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week,** came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

V1 - And **when the Sabbath was past**, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the *mother* of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him.

V2 - And **very early in the morning the first day of the week**, they came unto the sepulcher at the rising of the sun.

Luke 23:50-24:7

V1 - Now upon the **first of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared**, and certain *others* with them.

V56 - And **they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the Sabbath day** according to the commandment.

John 19:28-42

V42 - There laid they Y'HoShUA therefore **because of the Jews' preparation day**; for the sepulcher was nigh at hand.

V31 - The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the stake on the Sabbath day, (**for that Sabbath day was an high day**.) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and *that* they might be taken away.

V38 - And a superscription also was written over him in **letters of Greek, and Latin, and Hebrew**,

V3 - Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In **the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb**, according to the house of *their* fathers, a lamb for an house:

V6 - And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and **the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.**

V1 - Then Y'HoShUA six days before the Passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.



V13 - Took branches of palm trees, and **went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna:** Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of **YHWH.**

Psalm 22:1-18

V1 - **My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?**
why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?

V6 - But I *am* a worm, and no man; a **reproach of men, and despised of the people.**

V7 - All they that see me **laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head,**

V8 - He trusted on **YHWH that he would deliver him:** let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.




Psalm 22:1-18

V16 - For dogs have compassed me: the **assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet.**

V17 - I may tell all my bones: they **look and stare upon me.**



V18 - They **part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.**

V14 - I am **poured out like water,** and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels.

V15 - My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my **tongue cleaveth to my jaws;** and thou hast brought me into the dust of death.

Isaiah 53:1-12

V2 - For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: **he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.**



V3 - He is **despised and rejected of men**; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were *our* faces from him; **he was despised, and we esteemed him not.**

Isaiah 53:1-12

V5 - But he *was* **wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities**: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and **with his stripes we are healed.**

V7 - He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet **he opened not his mouth**: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, **so he openeth not his mouth.**

Isaiah 53:1-12

V8 - He was **taken from prison and from judgment:** and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

V9 - And he **made his grave with the wicked,** and **with the rich in his death;** because **he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.**

V11 - And he shall **wave the sheaf before YHWH,** to **be accepted for you:** on the morrow after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.

V17 – Y’HoShUA saith unto her, **Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father**: but go to my brethren, and **say unto them, I ascend unto my Father**, and your Father; and to my Mighty One, and your Mighty One.

V19 **Then the same day at evening**, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, **came Y’HoShUA and stood in the midst**, and saith unto them, Peace *be* unto you.

V20 - But now is Messiah risen from the dead, *and* become the firstfruits of them that slept.

V23 - But every man in his own order: Messiah[,] the firstfruits; afterward they that are Messiah's at his coming.

V4 - These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were **redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to the Mighty One and to the Lamb.**
