In Truth

We are required to worship God in "Spirit and Truth". We worship Him, not out of fear or a sense of grudging duty but out of an inner desire to create a deep, intimate relationship with our Father in heaven. For too long we have been choking on the truth but have quenched the spirit of worship and adoration. We work to see God's face and to feel His manifest presence in our assembling together and our lives, observing the works of His hands no longer satisfies a seeker of His love.

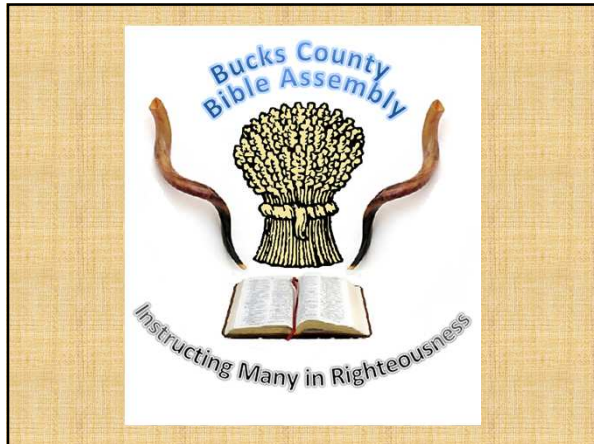

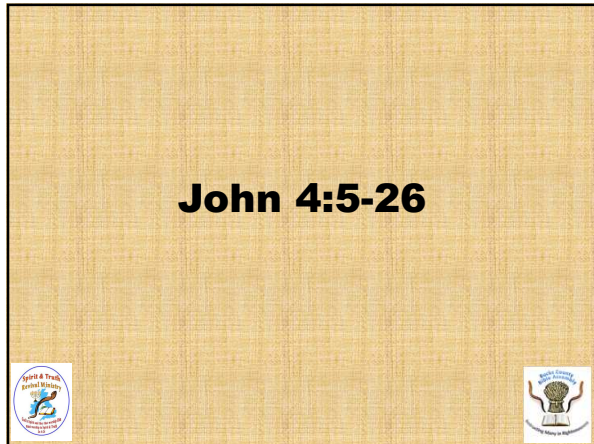
