Introduction

YHWH's truth is delivered through the Old and New Testaments. The spiritual examples for the church build on the physical example provided to us by the congregation of Israel. All believers are grafted into the root of YHWH's people, which is Messiah. Rather than shun the Old Testament as irrelevant we must carefully discern between YHWH's instructions given to all Israel and the oral tradition of Judah, the Jewish fables which became the burden of the Pharisees. To fully experience YHWH's great teachings for us we must recognize our Hebrew roots as the basis for spiritual Israel of the New Testament.



V4-5 - Abide in me, and I in you. **As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.**

V6-8 - And honour not his father or his mother, he shall be free. **Thus have ye made the Commandment of he Mighty One of none effect by your tradition.** Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying, **This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.**

V13-14 - This witness is true. **Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith; Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the truth.**

Acts 17:1-15

V10-12 - And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews. These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that **they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so. Therefore many of them believed;** also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few.
