The Renewed Covenant is made between YHWH and each one of us individually. We are therefore individually responsible for understanding and accepting the terms and conditions of the relationship. To do this we must study the scriptures, prove all things and holdfast to that which is good. Our core beliefs regarding this relationship are to repent, be baptized and obey the commandments; all else is a matter of personal conviction. We acknowledge that there will be differences of understanding between individual members of the body of Messiah but accept that to go against one's personal conviction is sin and we are not to place a stumbling block before our brethren. We accept different understandings in our assembly as long as they are not presented divisively and try to overturn our core beliefs.

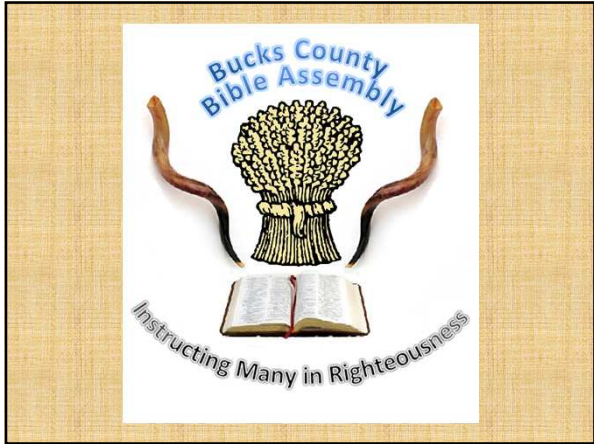
