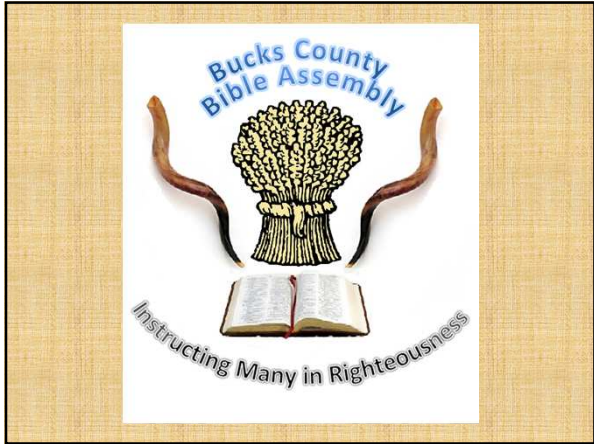

V5-7 - And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and **power was given unto him to continue forty and two months**. And he opened his mouth in blasphemy **against the Mighty One, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle**, and them that dwell in heaven. And it **was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them**: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

V15 - And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, **and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.**

V14-15 - And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud **One sat like unto the Son of Man, having on His head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.** And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, **Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.**

V19-20 - And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and **gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of the Mighty One.** And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs.
