V19-20 - And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the stake. And the writing was Y'HoWShUA OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS. This title then read many of the Jews: for the place where Y'HoWShUA was crucified was nigh to the city: and it was written in Hebrew, and Greek, and Latin.

V18 - For verily I say unto you, **Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.**

V19 - **Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.**

V21-22 - Ye have heard that it was said of them of old time, **Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment:** and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.
