V4-6 - Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I **YHWH** thy Mighty One am a jealous Mighty One, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me; And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep My commandments.

- I.* to burn with zeal
 - A.* to be heated or to boil with envy, hatred, anger
 - i.* in a good sense, to be zealous in the pursuit of good
 - B.* to desire earnestly, pursue
 - i.* to desire one earnestly, to strive after, busy one's self about him
 - ii.* to exert one's self for one (that he may not be torn from me)
 - iii.* to be the object of the zeal of others, to be zealously sought after
- C.* to envy
