# Leviticus 23:1-22 V2 - Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, the feasts of YHWH, which ye shall proclaim set apart convocations, these *are* my feasts. V3 - Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day *is* the Sabbath of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work : it *is* the Sabbath of YHWH in all your dwellings.


## Leviticus 23:1-8

V5 - In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is YHWH's Passover.

V6 - And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto YHWH : seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

V8 - But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto **THWH** seven days: in the seventh day is an set apart convocation: ye shall do no servile work. Spirit & Tradi general Ministry

#### Exodus 12:1-20

V2 - This month *shall be* unto you the beginning of months: **it** *shall be* **the first month of the year to you**.

V3 – Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, **In the tenth** *day* of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of *their* fathers, a lamb for an house:




#### Exodus 12:1-20

V6 - And ye shall **keep it up until the fourteenth day** of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.

V11 – And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the YHWH's

Passover.




V14 - And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to YHWH throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever.

V15 – Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.

#### Exodus 12:1-20

V17 – And ye shall observe *the feast of* unleavened bread; for **in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt**: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever.

V19 - Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses: for whosoever eateth that which is leavened, even that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger, or born in the land.




## Exodus 13:1-10

V3 - And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand YHWH brought you out from this *place*: there shall no leavened bread be eaten.

V8 - And thou shalt shew thy son in that day, saying, *This is done* because of that *which* YHWH did unto me when I came forth out of Egypt.

# Exodus 13:1-10 V9 - And it shall be for a sign unto thee upon thine hand, and for a memorial between thine eyes, that YHWH's law may be in thy mouth: for with a strong hand hath YHWH brought thee out of Egypt. 


# **Genesis 22:1-19**

V8 - And Abraham said, My son, the Mighty One will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.


V16 - And said, By myself have I sworn, saith YHWH, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son:

V11 - And he shall wave the sheaf before **YHWH**, to be accepted for you: **on the morrow after the** 




Sabbath the priest shall wave it.




V16 - Even unto the morrow after the seventh Sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto YHWH.




#### Exodus 34:10-28

V22 - And thou shalt observe the feast of weeks, of the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the feast of ingathering at the year's end.

V23 - Thrice in the year shall all your men children appear before the Master YHWH, the Mighty One of Israel.

V20 - ... All the firstborn of thy sons thou shalt redeem. And none shall appear before me empty.
