Why observe the Feasts?

2) Ezra 3:1-7

- v5 Appointed of YHWH

3) Ex 31:12-18

- v13 Sabbaths are a sign between YHWH and His people
- v16 Children of Israel shall observe the Sabbath as a perpetual covenant
- v17 It is a sign between Me and the children of Israel forever

Feast of Weeks

1) Lev 23:15-22

- v15 Count from the day after the Sabbath
- Jewish controversy about Sivan - Sadducees and Samaritans weekly Sabbath - Pharisees High day
- v16 To the day after the 7th Sabbath
- v17 2 wave loaves baked with leaven, firstfruits to YHWH

9) Ex 34:10-28

- v22 Firstfruits of the wheat harvest
- v23 Three times a year all your men shall appear before YHWH
- v19 None shall appear before Me empty handed

10) Ac 2:1-13

- v1 When the day of Pentecost had full come
- v4 Filled with the Ruach
- v6 Everyone heard them in there own language

Firstfruits

1) Lev 23:9-14

- v10 When you come in to the land you shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of the harvest
- v11 On the day after the Sabbath the Priest shall wave the sheaf to be accepted on your behalf
- v14 A statue forever throughout your generations

8) Jn 20:17-23

- v17 Do not cling to me for I have not yet ascended
- v17 and say to them I am ascending to My Father
- v19 The same day at evening Y'HoShUAH came and stood in the midst

Unleavened Bread

1) Lev 23:1-8

- v5 14th day is Passover of YHWH
- v6 15th Day feast of Unleavened bread
- v8 7th day shall be a Set Apart convocation

4) Ex 12:1-20

- v2 This month shall be the first month of the year
- v3 On the 10th day every man shall choose a lamb
- v6 Keep it to the 14th day and kill it at twilight
- v11 It is YHWH's Passover
- v14 This day shall be a memorial a feast to YHWH throughout your generations
- v15 Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread
- v17 You shall observe this day as an everlasting ordinance
- v19 For 7 days no leaven shall be found in your houses

5) Ex 13:1-10

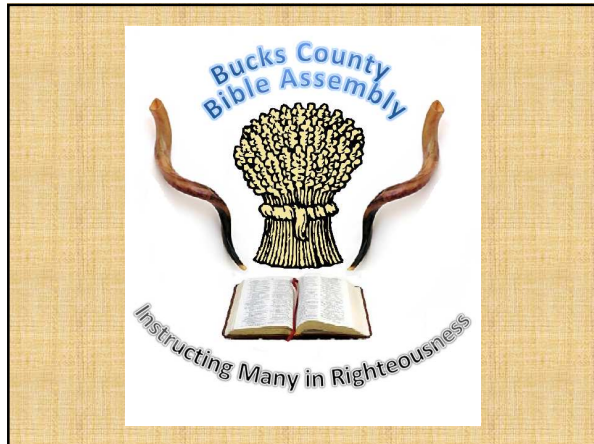
- v3 Remember this day in which you went out of Egypt
- v8 You shall tell your son what YHWH did on that day
- v9 It shall be a memorial that YHWH's law may be in your mouth
- v10 You shall keep this ordinance from Year to year

6) Ge 22:1-19

- v8 My son YHWH will provide for Himself a burnt offering
- v16 You have not withheld your only son

7) Jn 1:29-42

- v29 Behold the Lamb of YHWH who takes away the sin of the world
- v36 Behold the Lamb of YHWH

“The Spring High Days”



Leviticus 23:1-22



Leviticus 23:1-22

V2 - Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, **the feasts of YHWH**, which ye shall proclaim set apart convocations, these *are* my feasts.

V3 - Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day *is* the Sabbath of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work : it *is* **the Sabbath of YHWH** in all your dwellings.



Ezra 3:1-7





Ezra 3:1-7

V5 - And afterward *offered* the continual burnt offering, both of the new moons, and of **all the set feasts of YHWH that were consecrated**, and of every one that willingly offered a freewill offering unto **YHWH**.



Leviticus 23:1-8

Leviticus 23:1-8



V5 - In the fourteenth *day* of the first month at even *is* **YHWH's** Passover.

V6 - And on the **fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto YHWH** : seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

V8 - But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto **YHWH** seven days: in **the seventh day is an set apart convocation**: ye shall do no servile work.




Exodus 12:1-20

Exodus 12:1-20

V2 - This month *shall be* unto you the beginning of months: **it shall be the first month of the year to you.**

V3 – Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, **In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb**, according to the house of *their fathers*, a lamb for an house:



Exodus 12:1-20

V6 - And ye shall **keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month**: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.

V11 – And thus shall ye eat it; *with* your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: **it is the YHWH's Passover.**



Exodus 12:1-20

V14 - And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall **keep it a feast to YHWH throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever.**

V15 – **Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread**; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.



Exodus 12:1-20

V17 – And ye shall observe *the feast of unleavened bread*; for **in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt**: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever.

V19 - **Seven days shall there be no leaven found in your houses**: for whosoever eateth that which is leavened, even that soul shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel, whether he be a stranger, or born in the land.

Exodus 13:1-10

V3 - And Moses said unto the people, **Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt**, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand **YHWH** brought you out from this *place*: there shall no leavened bread be eaten.

V8 - And thou shalt shew thy son in that day, saying, **This is done because of that which YHWH did unto me when I came forth out of Egypt.**



Exodus 13:1-10

V9 - And it shall be for a sign unto thee upon thine hand, and for a memorial between thine eyes, that **YHWH's law may be in thy mouth**: for with a strong hand hath **YHWH** brought thee out of Egypt.

V10 - Thou shalt therefore keep this ordinance in his season from year to year.

V8 - And Abraham said, My son, **the Mighty One will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering**: so they went both of them together.

V16 - And said, By myself have I sworn, saith **YHWH**, for **because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son**:




John 1:29-42



John 1:29-42

V29 – The next day John seeth Y’HoShUAH coming unto him, and saith, **Behold the Lamb of the Mighty One, which taketh away the sin of the world.**

V36 - And looking upon Y’HoShUAH as he walked, he saith, **Behold the Lamb of the Mighty One!**




Leviticus 23:9-24

Leviticus 23:9-24

V10 - Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, **then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest:**

V11 - And he shall wave the sheaf before **YHWH**, to be accepted for you: **on the morrow after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.**



Leviticus 23:9-24

V14 - And ye shall eat neither bread, nor parched corn, nor green ears, until the selfsame day that ye have brought an offering unto your Mighty One: **it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.**



John 20:17-23



John 20:17-23

V17 – Y’HoShUAH saith unto her, **Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father:** but go to my brethren, and **say unto them, I ascend unto my Father,** and your Father; and to my Mighty One, and your Mighty One.



John 20:17-23

V19 **Then the same day at evening,** being the first *day* of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, **came Y’HoShUAH and stood in the midst,** and saith unto them, Peace *be* unto you.



Leviticus 23:15-22



Leviticus 23:15-22

V15 - And ye shall **count unto you from the morrow after the Sabbath**, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven Sabbaths shall be complete:

V16 - Even **unto the morrow after the seventh Sabbath shall ye number fifty days**; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto **YHWH**.



Leviticus 23:15-22

V17 - Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour; **they shall be baked with leaven; they are the firstfruits unto YHWH**



Exodus 34:10-28



Exodus 34:10-28

V22 - And thou shalt observe the feast of weeks, of the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the feast of ingathering at the year's end.

V23 - Thrice in the year shall all your men children appear before the Master **YHWH**, the Mighty One of Israel.

V20 - ... All the firstborn of thy sons thou shalt redeem. **And none shall appear before me empty.**

V1 - And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

V4 - And they were all filled with the Ruach HaKodesh, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

V8 - And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born?
