V1 - And **when the Sabbath was past**, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the *mother* of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him.

V2 - And **very early in the morning the first day of the week**, they came unto the sepulcher at the rising of the sun.

Luke 23:50-24:7

V1 - Now upon the **first of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared**, and certain *others* with them.

V56 - And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the Sabbath day according to the commandment.

Jn 19:28-42

V42 - There laid they Y'HoShUAH therefore **because of the Jews' preparation day**; for the sepulcher was nigh at hand.

V31 - The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain upon the stake on the Sabbath day, **(for that Sabbath day was an high day,)** besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and *that* they might be taken away.

V43 - And Y'HoShUAH said unto him, "Verily I say unto thee, **today shalt thou be with me in paradise**".

V43 - And Y'HoShUAH said unto him, "**Verily I say unto thee today**, shalt thou be with me in paradise".

V38 - And a superscription also was written over him in **letters of Greek, and Latin, and Hebrew**,
THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.

Exodus 12:1-11

V3 - Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the **tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb**, according to the house of *their fathers*, a lamb for an house:

V6 - And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and **the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.**

V46 - In one house shall it be eaten; thou shalt not carry forth ought of the flesh abroad out of the house; **neither shall ye break a bone thereof.**

Psalm 22:1-18




Psalm 22:1-18

V1 - My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?

V6 - But I *am* a worm, and no man; a **reproach of men**, and **despised of the people**.

V7 - All they that see me **laugh me to scorn**: they **shoot out the lip**, they **shake the head**,

V8 - He trusted on **YHWH** that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.




Psalm 22:1-18

V14 - I am **poured out like water**, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels. 15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my **tongue cleaveth to my jaws**; and thou hast brought me into the dust of death. 16 For dogs have compassed me: the **assembly of the wicked have enclosed me**: they **pierced my hands and my feet**. 17 I may tell all my bones: they **look and stare upon me**. 18 They **part my garments** among them, and **cast lots upon my vesture**.




Isaiah 53:1-12




Isaiah 53:1-12

V2 - For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: **he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.**

V3 - He is **despised and rejected of men**; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were *our* faces from him; **he was despised, and we esteemed him not.**




Isaiah 53:1-12

V5 - But he *was* **wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities**: the chastisement of our peace *was* upon him; and **with his stripes we are healed.**

V7 - He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet **he opened not his mouth**: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, **so he openeth not his mouth.**




Isaiah 53:1-12

V8 - He was **taken from prison and from judgment:** and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

V9 - And he **made his grave with the wicked,** and **with the rich in his death;** because **he had done no violence, neither *was any* deceit in his mouth.**

John 20:17-23

V17 – Y’HoShUAH saith unto her, **Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father:** but go to my brethren, and **say unto them, I ascend unto my Father,** and your Father; and to my Mighty One, and your Mighty One.



John 20:17-23

V19 Then the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, **came Y’HoShUAH and stood in the midst**, and saith unto them, Peace *be* unto you.

V20 - But now is Messiah risen from the dead, *and become the firstfruits of them that slept.*

V23 - But every man in his own order: Messiah[,] the firstfruits; afterward they that are Messiah’s at his coming.

Revelation 14:1-5

V4 - These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from *among men, being firstfruits to the Mighty One and to the Lamb.*
