Introduction

Sin is the transgression of YHWH's perfect Law. The penalty for sin is death, but YHWH offers us forgiveness of sin and eternal life as a gift. It is not YHWH's will for us to die, but that all mankind should come to repentance and be free from sin. A true Christian does not continue to live in sin. Whilst we can stumble into sin, after heartfelt repentance Y'HoShUA promises that we will be forgiven.



V24 - But when the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, and doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked man doeth, shall he live? **All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he hath trespassed, and in his sin that he hath sinned, in them shall he die.**

V21 - **But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die.**

V32 - For I have no pleasure in the death of him that dieth, saith the Master **YHWH**: wherefore turn yourselves, and live ye.

V31 - Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the **blasphemy against the Set Apart Spirit shall not be forgiven unto men.**



Matthew 12:31-37

V35 - A **good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things**: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.

V33 - Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for **the tree is known by his fruit.**

V7 - In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

V9 - **YHWH** is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, **not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.**

And shout for joy, all you upright in heart!**

V8 - If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

V9 - If we confess our sins, **He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins**, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

V5 - But whoso keepeth His word, in him verily is the **love of the Mighty One perfected: hereby know we that we are in Him.**
