V57 - Then they cried out with a loud voice, and stopped their ears, and ran upon him with one accord,

V51 - Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Set Apart Spirit: as your fathers did, so do ye.

V20 - And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

V9 - And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of the Mighty One, which hath power over these plagues: **and they repented not to give him glory.**

V11 - And blasphemed the Mighty One of heaven because of their pains and their sores, **and repented not of their deeds.**



1 Samuel 15:10-29



1 Samuel 15:10-29

V20-21 - And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I **have obeyed the voice of YHWH**, and have gone the way which **YHWH** sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites. But **the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which should have been utterly destroyed**, to sacrifice unto **YHWH** thy Mighty One in Gilgal.



1 Samuel 15:10-29

V15 - And Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites: **for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen, to sacrifice unto YHWH thy Mighty One;** and the rest we have utterly destroyed.

V23 - For **rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry.** Because thou hast rejected the word of **YHWH**, he hath also rejected thee from being king.



2 Chronicles 33:10-17

V10 - And **YHWH** spake to Manasseh, and to his people: **but they would not hearken.**

V12 - And **when he was in affliction, he besought YHWH his Mighty One, and humbled himself greatly** before the Mighty One of his fathers,

1 Kings 8:46-53

V47-48 - Yet if they shall bethink themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and **repent, and make supplication unto thee** in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, **We have sinned, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness; And so return unto thee with all their heart, and with all their soul,** in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto thee toward their land, which thou gavest unto their fathers, the city which thou hast chosen, and the house which I have built for thy name:

V3 - For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me.



2 Corinthians 7:1-12





2 Corinthians 7:1-12

V10 -For godly sorrow produces repentance *leading* to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.





Romans 6:1-14





Romans 6:1-14

V4 - Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Messiah was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, **even so we also should walk in newness of life.**



Matthew 6:5-15



Matthew 6:5-15

V12-15 - **And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.** And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. For **if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: but if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.**



Hebrews 12:1-29



Hebrews 12:1-29



V17 - For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, **he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears.**

V25 - See that you do not refuse Him who speaks. For if they did not escape who refused Him who spoke on earth, **much more shall we not escape if we turn away from Him who speaks from heaven:**



Hebrews 12:1-29

V28-29 - Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, **let us have grace, by which we may serve the Mighty One acceptably with reverence and godly fear.** For our Mighty One *is* a consuming fire.
