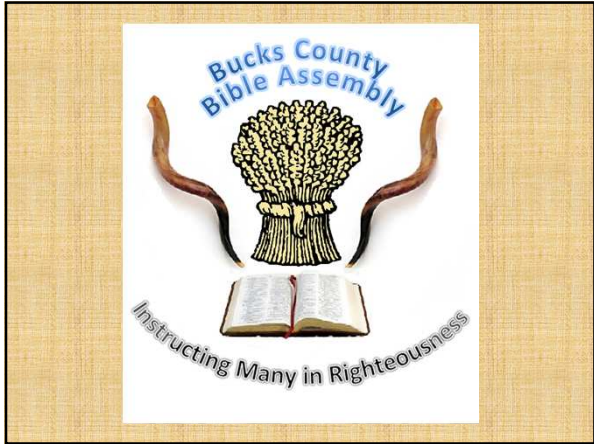

V8-11 - Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it set apart. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the Sabbath of **YHWH** thy Mighty One: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days **YHWH** made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore **YHWH** blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.
