V23-25 - And **YHWH** spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a Sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a set apart convocation. Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto **YHWH**.

Genesis' Hebrew-Chaldee Lexicon

כֶּחַ Prov. 7:20, and כֶּחַת Psalm 81:4, *the full moon*; Syr. كَعْحَات according to Isa Bar Ali (concerning whom see Pref. to smaller Hebr. Germ. Lex. p. xxv) is the first day of the full moon, also the whole time of the full moon, and so it is often used by Bar-helevus and Ephraim Syrus. The etymology is not clear to me, for it is not satisfactory to say that it is so called from the whole moon being then *covered with light* (from the root כָּחַת, כָּחַת). Verbs of covering are often applied in the sense of hiding and covering over, but never, as far as I know, to that of giving light.
